



CHAPTER 19

An Act respecting orders-in-council for the carrying out of the Lands and Forests Act

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 5 of the Lands and Forests Act (Revised R. S., c. 44,
Statutes, 1925, chapter 44) is amended by adding thereto ^{s. 5, am.}
the following paragraph:

“Without restricting the powers which the laws of the Province now in force grant to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, the latter may establish, with respect to the counties of Gaspé-North, Gaspé-South, Bonaventure and Charlevoix-Saguenay, stumpage dues or ground rents different from those which are in force in the remainder of the Province.” ^{Establishing of different stumpage dues, etc.}

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Coming into force.}
