



## CHAPTER 38

An Act to amend the Municipal Tax Exemption Act

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 6 of the Municipal Tax Exemption Act R. S., c. 117, (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 117) is replaced by the following: s. 6, replaced.

**“6.** No municipal corporation shall oblige a commercial traveller to procure a license for taking orders or selling goods, wares, or merchandise by sample, catalogue or price-list, or for delivering his merchandise, notwithstanding any provision to the contrary in any statute whatsoever; provided that such orders or sales be taken or made with merchants, traders or manufacturers only, in the ordinary course of their trade.” Commercial travellers' license.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
