



## CHAPTER 40

An Act to amend the Education Act respecting the collection of school taxes

*[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 399 of the Education Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 133, 1925, chapter 133) is replaced by the following sections: s. 399, replaced.

**“399.** The secretary-treasurer of such municipal council shall enter in a book or register, specially and exclusively intended for such purpose, the school taxes so collected, which taxes shall not be employed by a municipal corporation for any purpose whatsoever. Special entry of school taxes.

The secretary-treasurer of the said municipal council is, in addition, bound, as the school taxes are collected, to deposit the same in the name and to the credit of the said board, in a lawfully incorporated bank in the locality, or, if there be no such bank therein, in the nearest locality thereto. Deposit.

**“399a.** Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, any person who directly or indirectly infringes or attempts to infringe or abets or procures any person to infringe the provisions of section 399 of this act shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable, in addition to the costs, to a fine not exceeding two hundred dollars, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to an imprisonment not exceeding six months.” Offences and penalties.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
