



CHAPTER 43

An Act respecting the Montreal Protestant Central School Board

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The act 15 George V, chapter 45, is amended by adding thereto, after section 14 thereof, as replaced by the act 17 George V, chapter 42, section 1, the following sections:

"14a. The number of teachers and other employees employed by any local board, under annual contracts or otherwise, shall not exceed the number authorized by the Central Board, and the salaries to be paid to them shall not be in excess of the salaries authorized by the Central Board.

"14b. The Central Board may purchase school supplies, including coal, for use by any local board or boards in cases where it is considered by the Central Board to be desirable to do so."

2. The said act is amended by adding thereto, after section 24 thereof, as amended by the act 16 George V, chapter 47, section 4, the following section:

"24a. If any local board refuses or fails to follow the general or special instructions given by the Central Board and which the said Central Board may be legally entitled to give or incurs any expense that is not included in the budget and is not an expenditure approved by the Central Board, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, upon the ap-

plication of the Central Board and the recommendation of the Director of Protestant Education, may deprive such local board of its powers and duties and transfer the same to the Central Board, during pleasure.

But no action shall be taken under this section unless ten days written notice shall have been given to the local board by the Central Board of the time and place of such application and of the grounds invoked therein, and until the local board shall have been given a hearing thereon and an opportunity of replying to any such application."

Section 16 of the said act, as amended by the act 16 George V, chapter 47, section 1, and as replaced by the acts 17 George V, chapter 42, section 2, and 18 George V, chapter 51, section 1, and again amended by the acts 18 George V, chapter 52, section 1: 19 George V, chapter 48, section 2, and 20 George V, chapter 60, section 1, and again replaced by the act 21 George V, chapter 65, section 2, is again amended by replacing the word: "five", in the thirty-sixth line of subsection 5 thereof, by the word: "six".
