



## CHAPTER 44

An Act to amend the Courts of Justice Act respecting the signing of certain judgments

*[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 33 of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 145) is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

"Likewise, the chief justice of the Superior Court or the acting chief justice, as the case may be, may and has always had the power to sign a judgment rendered by a judge since deceased, provided that he be satisfied that the text of the judgment presented to him to be signed is in conformity with the judgment which has been rendered."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
