



CHAPTER 44

An Act to amend the Courts of Justice Act respecting the signing of certain judgments

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 33 of the Courts of Justice Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 145) is amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

“Likewise, the chief justice of the Superior Court or the acting chief justice, as the case may be, may and has always had the power to sign a judgment rendered by a judge since deceased, provided that he be satisfied that the text of the judgment presented to him to be signed is in conformity with the judgment which has been rendered.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
