



## CHAPTER 45

### An Act to amend the Jury Act respecting the indemnity of jurors

[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 71 of the Jury Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., chapter 150), as amended by the act 23 George V, chapter c. 150, s. 71, 67, section 27, is replaced by the following:

**“71.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may adopt Indemnity and, from time to time, amend or repeal regulations to of jurors. determine, in any district, the indemnity which each juror shall receive, taking into account the particular circumstances in each district as well as the special circumstances resulting from the period when the jurors have to appear, the place of their residence, the facilities or difficulties of communication between their place of residence and the Court House, the total or partial incapacity to attend to their occupations by reason of their total or partial absence from their residence or place of business.

Such indemnity shall be paid to the juror by the sheriff Payment. upon the certificate of the clerk of the peace or of the clerk of the Crown, as the case may be.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on such date as it may Coming into please the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to fix by pro- force. clamation.
