



CHAPTER 65

An Act to amend the Quebec Insurance Act respecting mutual benefit associations

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 214 of the Quebec Insurance Act (Revised R. S., c. 243, Statutes, 1925, chapter 243) is amended by replacing sub-^{s. 214, am.}section 3 thereof by the following:

“3. A mutual benefit association may, instead of setting out in full the terms or conditions of the contract as provided by subsection 1 of this section, print on the face of the document evidencing the contract the following words: “This certificate is subject to the constitution and by-laws of the association, now in force or which will be in force in the future”. A member of the association is entitled to receive, on application, a copy of such by-laws.”
