



CHAPTER 70

An Act respecting the approval of the subdivision of lands by municipal authorities, relating to streets and lanes

[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Cadastre Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter R. S., c. 261, 261) is amended by adding thereto, after section 17 thereof, s. 17a, added. the following section:

“**17a.** No plan and book of reference of any subdivision or redivision, containing streets or lanes, may be considered by the Minister, unless accompanied by a certificate from the secretary-treasurer of the municipal corporation in the territory of which the immoveable subdivided or redivided is situated, to the effect that the said plan and book of reference, in so far as such streets or lanes are concerned, have been approved by the council.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
