



CHAPTER 70

An Act respecting the approval of the subdivision of lands
by municipal authorities, relating to streets and lanes

[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Cadastre Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter R.S., c. 261, 261) is amended by adding thereto, after section 17 thereof, ^{s. 17a, added.} the following section:
