



## CHAPTER 74

An Act to amend the Civil Code and the Code of Civil Procedure respecting non-juridical days

[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 17 of the Civil Code, as contained in Article C. C., art 5775 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, and as amended by the acts 56 Victoria, chapter 38, section 1; 60 Victoria, chapter 50, section 1, and 2 Edward VII, chapter 12, section 3, is again amended by inserting therein, after the word: "Ascension", in the second line of sub-paragraph 3 of paragraph 14 of the Schedule thereof, the words and figures: " , the 24th of June being St. John the Baptist's day". <sup>17, am.</sup>

**2.** Article 7 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended C. C. P., art. by the act 2 Edward VII, chapter 12, section 2, is again amended by inserting therein, after the word: "Ascension", in the second line of sub-paragraph 3 thereof, the words and figures: " , the 24th of June being St. John the Baptist's day". <sup>7, am.</sup>

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. <sup>Coming into force.</sup>
