



CHAPTER 76

An Act to amend Articles 15 and 554 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 15 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended C. C. P., art. 15, am. by the acts 62 Victoria, chapter 52, section 1; 9 Edward VII, chapter 73, section 2; 1 George V (1910), chapter 42, section 1; 5 George V, chapter 51, section 2; 5 George V, chapter 81, section 1; 14 George V, chapter 42, section 2; 19 George V, chapter 85, section 6, and 23 George V, chapter 112, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto, at the end thereof, the following paragraph:

“The judge who has heard a contested case may, however, in his discretion, render judgment between the thirtieth day of June and the first day of September.” Rendering of judgment.

2. Article 554 of the said Code is amended by replacing C. C. P., art. 554, am. the words: “six months”, in the first line of the fourth paragraph thereof, by the words: “one month”.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into force. sanction.
