



CHAPTER 84

An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting the qualification of electors

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 243 of the Municipal Code, as amended by M. C., art. the act 19 George V, chapter 89, section 1, is again amended ^{243, am.} by adding thereto, at the end thereof, the following paragraph:

“Every person who is entered on the valuation roll in force in the municipality as proprietor, when at the time of exercising the right to vote he or she qualifies as a lessee or occupant contemplated in paragraph 3, shall retain the qualification of elector; in the same way the person entered on the said roll as lessee or occupant shall retain the qualification of elector if, at the time of exercising such right to vote, he or she qualifies as a proprietor contemplated in the said paragraph 3.”

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. ^{Coming into force.}
