



CHAPTER 91

An Act to authorize the city of Three Rivers and certain other municipalities to contribute to the celebration of the third centenary of the founding of Three Rivers

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 9 of the Appropriation Act 23 George V, chapter 126, the city of Three Rivers may appropriate, generally, for the cost of celebrating the third centenary of the founding of Three Rivers, the sum of thirty-four thousand nine hundred and nineteen dollars and thirty-five cents, remaining available out of the amount borrowed under the loan by-law No. 75.

2. The municipal council of any local or county municipality situated in the electoral districts of Champlain, Nicolet, Laviolette, Maskinongé and St. Maurice, whether incorporated under a general or by a special act, and also the council of the parish municipality of *Trois-Rivières*, may contribute to the celebrating of the third centenary of the founding of Three Rivers and, for such purpose, vote, by resolution, a subsidy appropriated generally to the cost of celebrating the said event.

Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, such resolution adopted under the preceding paragraph shall come into force after having been approved by the Quebec Municipal Commission.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
