



CHAPTER 93

An Act respecting the validation of a by-law of the city of Sherbrooke

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

WHEREAS the municipal council of the city of Sherbrooke, on the 22nd of September, 1933, passed a by-law bearing the No. 537, authorizing a transfer of funds to the amount of one hundred and twenty-six thousand seven hundred and thirty-two dollars and seventeen cents, part of which, namely, the sum of eighty-seven thousand nine hundred and thirty-nine dollars and thirty-one cents, to be paid into the general accounts of the city to reimburse a part of the cost of works undertaken to relieve unemployment; Preamble.

Whereas the said by-law was submitted to the elector-proprietors a first time, and the vote was then favourable in value, and against in number;

Whereas the council then decided, by resolution, to submit such by-law to the vote of the electors a second time;

Whereas on such second vote the by-law was approved in number and in value;

Whereas doubts have arisen as to the legality of the above procedure; and

Whereas it is in the public interest that such by-law be validated;

Therefore, His Majesty with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. By-law number 537 adopted by the municipal council of the city of Sherbrooke on the 22nd of September, 1933, is validated for all legal purposes. Validation of certain by-law.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
