



CHAPTER 103

An Act respecting the town of Black Lake

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

WHEREAS the town of Black Lake, by a judgment of Preamble.
the Superior Court, dated the third day of August,
1932, was declared in default and placed under the control
of the Quebec Municipal Commission;

Whereas, under subsection 3 of section 16 of chapter
101 of the act 8 Edward VII, the town of Black Lake has the
right to impose, during twenty years from the coming into
force of the said act, on persons or companies owning or
occupying land comprised within the municipality, certain
special annual taxes;

Whereas, for the proper administration of the said town,
it is necessary to extend for fifteen years the period of
twenty years above-mentioned;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 16 of the act 8 Edward VII, chapter 101, is 8 Ed. VII,
amended by replacing the word: "twenty", in the second ^{c. 101, s. 16,}
line of subsection 3 thereof, by the word: "thirty-five". ^{am.}

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into}
sanction. ^{force.}
