



CHAPTER 133

An Act to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Thomas Joseph McNally among its members

[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]

WHEREAS Thomas Joseph McNally, of the city of ^{Preamble.} Montreal, Province of Quebec, has, by his petition, represented:

That, after a course in classical studies, he entered McGill University in the year 1921, where he studied for three years in the faculty of medicine and dentistry, and that he later on entered the University of Montreal, where, after he completed four additional years in the study of dental surgery, he received the degree of Doctor of Dental Surgery, from the said University of Montreal; and

That he has not undergone the examinations of the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, for admission to study, for the profession of Doctor of Dental Surgery; and

That, on the 14th day of October 1933, at a regular meeting, the Provincial Board of Dental Surgery of the Province of Quebec, passed a resolution authorizing him to present a private Bill to the Legislature, to authorize the College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec, to admit him as one of its members conditionally upon his passing the final examinations to obtain the license to practise; and

Whereas the said Thomas Joseph McNally has prayed for the passing of an act for such purpose and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Admission of T. J. McNally by College of Dental Surgeons. **1.** The College of Dental Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Thomas Joseph McNally among its members from the date of his passing its final examinations to obtain the license to practise.

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
