



## CHAPTER 134

### An Act respecting the adoption of Rosa Mongrain

[Assented to, the 20th of April, 1934]

**W**HEREAS Gustave Hardy has, by his petition, re-<sup>Preamble.</sup>  
sented that a long time before the passing of the  
Adoption Act, he had, in fact, adopted Rosa Mongrain  
whom he had brought up as his daughter and provided for  
her subsistence and education, and that, under the circum-  
stances, it is expedient to pass an act to legalize the adoption  
of the said Rosa Mongrain and to enact that she shall  
be deemed to be the adopted daughter of Gustave Hardy,  
for all legal purposes;

Whereas the said Rosa Mongrain and her husband have  
acquiesced in the said petition, and have prayed for the  
continuance of this petition, owing to the death of the said  
Gustave Hardy on the 3rd of April, 1934; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the prayer therein con-  
tained;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of  
Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The adoption of Rosa Mongrain by Gustave Hardy  
in August, 1890, is legalized from the said date and the  
said Rosa Mongrain shall be deemed to be the adopted  
daughter of the said Gustave Hardy, enjoying from the  
said date all the rights and privileges granted by the  
Adoption Act. <sup>Validation

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its  
sanction. <sup>Coming into  
force.</sup>
