



CHAPTER 138

An Act to allow Jalmar Frederick Susta to change his name
to that of Charles Jalmar Frederick Anderson

[Assented to, the 7th of March, 1934]

WHEREAS Jalmar Frederick Susta, machinist, of the Preamble.
city and district of Quebec, has, by petition, set forth
his desire to change his name from Susta to that of Charles
Jalmar Frederick Anderson, considering that he has since
his birth always been known under such name;

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act for such
purpose; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant the said prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The said Jalmar Frederick Susta shall hereafter be designated and known by the name of Charles Jalmar Frederick Anderson, and by the latter name may hereafter claim, exercise and enjoy all advantages, benefits, rights and titles which, without such change of name, he would have been entitled to claim, exercise or enjoy; and all contracts, covenants and agreements made and entered into by him, by and under the name of Jalmar Frederick Susta, shall avail to and be binding on him and be deemed to be entered into by him under the name of Charles Jalmar Frederick Anderson; and all legacies or bequests or gifts contained in any will or deed of donation, policy of insurance or otherwise, made in his favour by the name of Jalmar Frederick Susta, shall avail to him as if the name of Charles Jalmar Frederick Anderson had been mentioned therein, and also by the latter name he may recover, have, hold

and possess and be capable of inheriting all real or personal property and rights of any nature or kind whatsoever, which he may at present have, hold or possess, or which hereafter he may be capable of inheriting, recovering, holding or possessing, as fully and for the same extent as if the change of name had not hereby been made.

2. All obligations entered into by the said Charles Jalmar Frederick Anderson, under his former name, shall be exigible against him under the latter, and all suits or proceedings at law to which he may be a party, pending in any court of this Province, shall not be affected by this act, but shall be continued to judgment and execution as if this act had not been passed.

3. All rights and privileges generally of whatever nature and kind soever that may be acquired under this act by the said Charles Jalmar Frederick Anderson shall apply to his children and descendants.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
