



## CHAPTER 15

### An Act to amend the Quebec License Act

[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 9 of the Quebec License Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 25) is replaced by the following: R. S., c. 25, s. 9, replaced.

“**9.** The Provincial Treasurer may prevent the issue of a license or may suspend, at any time, a license issued, for any reason he deems valid. He may also annul, at any time, a license issued, for any reason he deems valid, and remit to the licensee a proportionate part of the duty and fee paid.” Suspension, etc., of license.

**2.** Section 119 of the said act, as enacted by the act 22 George V, chapter 22, section 4, is amended: R. S., c. 25, s. 119, am.

*a.* By replacing the words: “one hundred”, in the first line of sub-paragraph 1 thereof, by the word: “twenty-five”;

*b.* By replacing the word: “fifty”, in the first line of sub-paragraph 2 thereof, by the word: “twenty-five”.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
