



## CHAPTER 16

### An Act to validate certain registrations

*[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The registrations, effected before the date of the validation coming into force of this act, of the certificates issued under of certain the Quebec Succession Duties' Act (Revised Statutes, registra- 1925, chapter 29), and of those issued under the Property tions. Transfer Duty Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 28), or under any acts replaced by the said acts, as well as the certificates of registration concerning such registrations, are validated notwithstanding the failure to affix, at the time of the registration, the stamps required by law, provided, however, that their validity be incontestable in Proviso. all other respects and that the duties owed to the Province be paid.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into sanction. force.
