



CHAPTER 18

An Act to amend the Gasoline Handling Act

[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Gasoline Handling Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 36A, Chapter 36A), as enacted by the act 22 George V, chapter 31, section 1, is amended by inserting therein, after section 8 thereof, the following section:

“**Sa.** In order to verify the quantities of oil acquired by the manufacturer of gasoline and the quantities of gasoline manufactured, acquired or sold by the manufacturer of gasoline, and the quantities of gasoline which he has on hand, the Provincial Treasurer may require from the manufacturer of gasoline the installation, at the cost of the latter, of automatic meters or such other apparatus approved of by the Provincial Treasurer, the use whereof to be controlled by the latter. He may also for the same purpose require the use of such other means or such other methods which he may deem advisable.”

Verification of quantities of oil and gasoline by automatic meters, etc.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
