



CHAPTER 20

An Act respecting the exportation of hydro-electric power

[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any provision prohibiting the ex-
portation, outside of Canada, of electric power, contained, ^{Suspension}

the Province or in which it has rights of ownership or ^{port electric}
other rights, the Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, for
the period or periods of time that he may fix and on such
terms and conditions as he may determine, suspend the
effect of such prohibition; provided, however, that the ^{Proviso.}
quantity of electric power, the exportation whereof may
be thus authorized, shall not exceed in all three hundred
thousand horsepower, and provided also that the sale price
of the electric power so exported be not below that for
which it is sold in the Province of Quebec.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into}
sanction. ^{force.}
