



## CHAPTER 22

### An Act to amend the Coöperative Agricultural Association Act

[Assented to, the 29th of March, 1933]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Coöperative Agricultural Association Act (Re- R. S., c. 57, vised Statutes, 1925, chapter 57) is amended by adding s. 31b, added thereto, after section 31a thereof, as enacted by the act 21 George V, chapter 40, section 3, the following section:

**“31b.** No person carrying on business alone under a firm name, and no commercial partnership or association not incorporated, shall use in a firm name the word “co-operative”, unless incorporated under this act.”

Use of word “coöperative” in firm name.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction but shall not apply to persons, partnerships or associations using such word at the coming into force of this act.

Coming into force. Restriction.
