



CHAPTER 54

An Act to amend the Education Act respecting the sale of
immoveables for taxes

[Assented to, the 29th of March, 1933]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 418 of the Education Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 133,
1925, chapter 133) is amended by adding thereto, after the ^{s. 418, am.}
word: "council", in the third line thereof, the words: "and

are situated the said immoveables".

2. The said act is amended by adding thereto, after ^{Id., s. 418a,}
section 418 thereof, the following section: ^{added.}

corporation must, if he has not already done so under
section 418, transmit to the secretary-treasurer of the
county council, before the 31st of December, a statement
showing the amount of school taxes and monthly fees due
and affecting each such immoveable for school purposes;
the secretary-treasurer of the county council must take such
claim into account in preparing his list, and such amount
shall be paid out of the proceeds of the sale made by the
secretary-treasurer of the county council."

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into}
