



CHAPTER 65

An Act to grant concurrent jurisdiction to the court in the judicial district of Kamouraska over certain townships in the electoral district of Rimouski

[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, as follows:

1. The Courts of Justice Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 145, chapter 145) is amended by adding thereto, after section 42 thereof, the following section:

"42a. The court in the district of Kamouraska shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the court in the district of Rimouski over the townships of Biencourt and Bédard in the electoral district of Rimouski. Concurrent jurisdiction over certain townships.

Such concurrent jurisdiction shall extend to all the officers of the court."

2. The said act is amended by adding thereto, after section 63 thereof, the following section:

"63a. The court in the district of Kamouraska shall have concurrent jurisdiction with the court in the district of Rimouski over the townships of Biencourt and Bédard in the electoral district of Rimouski. Concurrent jurisdiction over certain townships.

Such concurrent jurisdiction shall extend to all the officers of the court."

3. Cases or proceedings commenced and pending at the coming into force of this act shall be continued, and the judgments in such matters, and those already obtained, shall be executed as if this act had not been passed. Cases, etc., continued.

4. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
