



CHAPTER 68

An Act respecting the Building and Jury Fund

[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. From and after the date fixed by the proclamation mentioned in section 4, the sums which under any act must be paid into the building and jury fund shall be paid into the consolidated revenue fund; and from and after the said date all expenditure imputable to the building and jury fund shall be paid out of the sums voted each year by the Legislature.

2. The provisions of this act shall not affect the provisions respecting the use of stamps contemplated by section 14 of the Stamp Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 24), except that the sums which, before the date fixed by the proclamation mentioned in section 4, were paid into the building and jury fund shall, after such date, be paid into the consolidated revenue fund.

3. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council shall have power to do and authorize such acts and things and to make from time to time such orders and regulations as he may deem necessary to facilitate the carrying out of this act, and he may suspend or add to any provisions of any act within the jurisdiction of the Legislature, insofar as the building and jury fund is concerned.

4. This act shall come into force on such date as it may please the Lieutenant-Governor in Council to fix by proclamation.
