



CHAPTER 102

An Act to amend Articles 180 and 1296 of the Civil Code

[Assented to, the 29th of March, 1933]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 180 of the Civil Code, as replaced by the act C. C., art. 21 George V, chapter 101, section 4, is amended by adding ^{180, am.} thereto the following paragraph:

“The judge may also, in such case, authorize the wife to ^{Wife as} become a public trader, but then for all that relates to her ^{public} trade the wife does not bind her husband, even if there ^{trader.} be community between them.”

2. Article 1296 of the said Code is amended by adding ^{C. C., art.} thereto, after the word: “trader”, in the fourth line ^{1296, am.} thereof, the words: “authorized in accordance with article 179”.

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into} sanction. ^{force.}
