



## CHAPTER 108

### An Act to amend Article 2005 of the Civil Code

*[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 2005 of the Civil Code, as replaced by article C. C., art. 5828 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, and by the act 61 2005, replaced.  
Victoria, chapter 46, section 1, is again replaced by the  
following:

**"2005.** In the case of a lease in authentic form the Privilege of  
privilege of the lessor extends to all rent that is due and lessor in case

If the lease be not in authentic form the privilege, in Id., when

shall have the same effect as the authentic lease from the  
date of its registration."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into  
sanction. force.
