



CHAPTER 109

An Act to amend the Civil Code respecting the description
and registration of the right to cut timber

[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 2042 of the Civil Code, as it appears in article C. C., art.
5831 of the Revised Statutes, 1888, is amended by adding ^{2042, am.}
thereto the following paragraph:

“When, however, the hypothec affects a right to cut timber on public lands, such right is sufficiently described if the deed designates it as a timber limit or a timber license and describes, in the same manner as in the license in force, the public lands affected by such right.”

2. Article 2168 of the said Code, as amended by the C. C., art.
acts 5 George V, chapter 77, section 1, and 6 George V, ^{2168, am.}
chapter 35, section 1, is again amended by adding thereto
the following paragraph:

“Nevertheless, a right to cut timber on public lands is sufficiently described in any document whatsoever if it is designated as a timber limit or a timber license and if the public lands affected by such right are described in the same manner as in the license in force.”
