



## CHAPTER 113

An Act to amend Article 96 of the Code of Civil Procedure

*[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1933]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 96 of the Code of Civil Procedure is amended C. C. P.,  
by adding thereto the following paragraph: art. 96, am.

“In the case where the defendant cannot be found, the Instituting  
action may be instituted before the court of the domicile of action in  
of the consort applying for separation and in such case the certain case.  
defendant must be summoned through the newspapers.”

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into  
sanction. force.
