



## CHAPTER 115

An Act to amend Article 598 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 13th of April, 1933]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Article 598 of the Code of Civil Procedure, as amended by the acts 13 George V, chapter 79, section 1; 14 George V, chapter 80, section 7, and 18 George V, chapter 91, section 1, is again amended: C. C. P., art. 598, am.

*a.* By replacing sub-paragraph 8 thereof by the following:

“8. All tools and implements of any kind whatsoever used by a farmer for the exploitation of his farm, land, maple grove or fruit trees; one span of plough-horses or a yoke of oxen, or one plough-horse and one ox, ten other cattle, six sheep, five pigs, the poultry, and the grain and fodder necessary for the wintering or fattening of such animals;” Exemptions from seizure.

*b.* By adding thereto, after sub-paragraph 10 thereof, the following sub-paragraphs:

“10*a.* One horse, one summer vehicle, one winter vehicle and the harness, used by a carter or driver for earning his livelihood; Idem.

“10*b.* In the case of a person not being a farmer: one cow, two pigs, the poultry, four sheep, the wool of such sheep, the stuff manufactured with such wool, the grain, the hay and other fodder intended for feeding the said animals;” Idem.

*c.* By replacing sub-paragraph 11 thereof by the following:

“11. Bees and the hives which form the apiary, as well as all the implements and accessories necessary for the working of the apiary;” Idem.

*d.* By replacing the word and figure: "and 10", in the second line of the last paragraph thereof, by the figures and word: ",10, 10a and 10b".

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
