CHAPTER 121

An Act to amend the Municipal Code respecting the sale of
immoveables for taxes

[Assented to, the 29th of March, 1933]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 727 of the Municipal Code is amended by M. C., art.
adding thereto, after sub-paragraph 3 thereof, the following ^{727, am.}
paragraph:

“The secretary-treasurer must transmit, at the same ^{Transmis-}
time, an extract of such statement to the office of the school ^{sion of}
municipality within which are situated such immoveables.” ^{extract.}

2. The said Code is amended by adding thereto, after M. C., art.
article 727 thereof, the following article: ^{727a, added.}

“**727a.** When he has received from the secretary-^{Transmis-}
treasurer of the school commissioners or school trustees a ^{sion of}
statement of the immoveables to be sold by the secretary-^{statement of}
treasurer of the county council for school taxes and monthly ^{taxes due.}
fees due, the secretary-treasurer of the local corporation
must, if he has not already done so under the preceding
article, transmit to the secretary-treasurer of the county
council, before the 31st of December, a statement showing
the amount of taxes due and affecting each such immove-
able property for municipal purposes; the secretary-
treasurer of the county council must take such claim into
account in preparing his list, and such amount shall be
paid out of the proceeds of the sale made by the secretary-
treasurer of the county council.”

3. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming}
sanction. ^{into force.}
