



CHAPTER 131

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Levis

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1933]

WHEREAS the city of Levis has, by its petition, represented that it is necessary for the proper administration of its affairs, that its charter, the act 20 George V, chapter 111, be amended, and that new provisions be added thereto, and whereas it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

- 1.** No recourse may be had against the city to recover the duties and taxes hitherto paid to the city by insurance companies. No recourse.
- 2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
