



CHAPTER 133

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Grand'Mère

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1933]

WHEREAS the city of Grand'Mère has, by its petition, Preamble. represented that, in order to aid its unemployed, it has had certain works of a permanent nature done, which have obliged it to modify and exceed the appropriations of its loan by-laws; that it has provided for the expenses of the said works by means of a by-law adopted afterwards; that it is desirable to have the said by-law ratified and validated, in order to reëstablish equilibrium in the city finances; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The charter of the city of Grand'Mère, the act 1 Geo. V 1 George V (1910), chapter 54, as amended by the acts (1910), c. 3 George V, chapter 67; 9 George V, chapter 103; 10^{54, s. 52a,} George V, chapter 93; 11 George V, chapter 119; 20^{added.} George V, chapter 119; 21 George V, chapter 166, and 22 George V, chapter 113, is again amended by inserting therein, after section 52 thereof, the following section:

"52a. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, upon Approval of the recommendation of the Quebec Municipal Commission, loan by-law approve by-law No. 301 of the city of Grand'Mère, pro- No. 301 by Lt.-Gov. viding for a loan of sixty thousand dollars as well as for a in C. transfer of twenty-eight thousand six hundred and thirty-five dollars and fifty-one cents, the whole to cover unemployment aid works.

Coming into force thereof. The said by-law, so approved by the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, shall have full force and effect, subject to promulgation only."

Coming into force. **2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
