



## CHAPTER 178

An Act to authorize the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec to admit Laval Langlois to the practice of the notarial profession, after examination

*[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1933]*

**W**HEREAS Laval Langlois, notarial clerk, of the parish Preamble.  
of Ste. Claire, Dorchester county, has, by his petition, represented:

That he is a British subject by birth;

That he holds a diploma of Bachelor of Arts from Montreal University, dated the 30th of June, 1930;

That, in September, 1930, he was entered as a student at the law faculty of Laval University, Quebec;

That, since then he has regularly attended courses at the law faculty of Laval University, Quebec, and has hitherto successfully undergone all examinations required by the university course;

That, in the spring of 1933, he will present himself before Laval University to undergo the final examinations to obtain the title of Bachelor or Licentiate of Law;

That he was indentured to Mtre Onésime Gagnon, lawyer, of the city of Quebec, by deed before Joseph G. Couture, notary, at Quebec, on the 15th of October, 1930, under No. 15452 of his minutes, and regularly attended as lawyer's clerk the office of his patron, the said Onésime Gagnon, during the university year 1930-1931;

That he was admitted to the study of the legal profession on the 14th of January, 1931, by the Bar of the Province of Quebec;

That, in the month of July, 1931, he decided not to become a lawyer but to practise the notarial profession;

That he was admitted to the study of the notarial profession on the 17th of July, 1931, by the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec;

That he was indentured as notarial clerk to Georges Michel Giroux, notary, at Quebec, on the 30th of July, 1931, by deed executed before Joseph Sirois, notary, Quebec, under No. 10661 of his minutes, and, according to law, this indenture was registered at the secretary's office of the Board of Notaries, at Quebec, on the 31st of July, 1931, under No. 787;

That, since then, he has regularly attended, as notarial clerk, the office of his patron, notary Georges Michel Giroux;

That, according to law, his time of clerkship as lawyer's clerk cannot count for his clerkship as notarial clerk, although both professions are concerned with the science of law;

That, as things now stand, he would not be allowed to undergo his examinations for admission to the practice of the notarial profession, except at the session of the Board of Notaries, which will be held in 1934, provided he is then a Licentiate or Bachelor of Law;

That, if, in October, 1930, he had been indentured to a notary, he would be allowed to undergo his examinations for admission to the practice of the notarial profession, at the 1933 session of the Board of Notaries, provided he then holds a diploma of Bachelor or Licentiate in Law of Laval University;

That he wishes that his time of clerkship as lawyer's clerk be counted in the legal time of clerkship which he has to spend as notarial clerk;

That he has obtained the consent of the Council of the Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec that an act be passed to authorize the said Board of Notaries to admit him to the practice of the notarial profession, after examination; and

Whereas he has prayed for the passing of an act to this effect, and it is expedient to grant his prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The Board of Notaries of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Laval Langlois to the practice of the notarial profession and to grant him a commission,

dated the 15th of October, 1933, provided that, at the 1933 session of the Board of Notaries, he be holder of a diploma of Bachelor or Licentiate in Law from Laval University and successfully undergoes the examinations for admission to the practice of such profession.
