



## CHAPTER 179

An Act to authorize the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec to admit Fernand Lizotte to the practice of medicine, after examinations

[Assented to, the 15th of March, 1933]

**W**HEREAS Fernand Lizotte, of the city of Levis, dis-<sup>Preamble.</sup>trict of Quebec, has, by his petition, represented:

That, in September, 1926, he was admitted among the medical students of Laval University, Quebec, and attended the courses of the said university during the five prescribed years;

That, in September, 1931, Laval University, Quebec, granted him a diploma of Doctor of Medicine;

That he began to attend the courses of the said University without having previously obtained the degree of bachelor in the said University;

That he made his classical course at Levis College where he studied letters and sciences;

That in June, 1932, only, he obtained his degree of Bachelor of Letters from the said Laval University, having been unable, for major reasons and owing to circumstances beyond his control, to obtain his diploma of bachelor before entering the said University;

That, owing to the foregoing, the College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec has consented to to a bill being presented authorizing the said petitioner to practise medicine, after undergoing certain examinations required by the said College; and

Whereas it is expedient to grant such prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

College of Physicians and Surgeons authorized to admit Fernand Lizotte.

**1.** The College of Physicians and Surgeons of the Province of Quebec is authorized to admit the said Fernand Lizotte amongst its members and to grant him the required license to practise medicine in the Province of Quebec, after having passed the professional examinations before the Provincial Medical Board.

Coming into force.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
