



CHAPTER 13

An Act respecting Verdun Protestant Hospital

[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of paragraph *a* of section 1 of the act 20 George V, chapter 11, and any provisions to the contrary in the contract between the Government of the Province and Verdun Protestant Hospital, confirmed and ratified by the act 21 George V, chapter 14, the Government of the Province of Quebec shall pay semi-annually to those entitled thereto the interest on the loan of three hundred thousand dollars contracted by Verdun Protestant Hospital and shall provide each year for the sinking-fund required to repay such loan at maturity. The sums necessary for such purposes shall be taken from the credits appropriated by the Legislature for lunatic asylums.

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
