



## CHAPTER 27

### An Act to amend the Motor Vehicle Act

*[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]*

**H**IS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Motor Vehicle Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 35, chapter 35) is amended by inserting therein, after section 41a thereof, as enacted by the act 19 George V, chapter 21, section 2, the following section:

**“41b.** The Minister of Roads may place a suitable sign Stop at sign placed at intersection of roads. near an intersection or bifurcation of two public roads outside of cities and towns, and every driver of a motor vehicle driving along a road where such sign is placed, must bring such motor vehicle to a stop for a moment near such intersection or bifurcation.”
