



CHAPTER 34

An Act to amend Section 144 of the Lands and Forests Act

[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 144 of the Lands and Forests Act (Revised R. S., c. 44, Statutes, 1925, chapter 44) is amended by replacing the ^{s. 144, am.} first paragraph thereof by the following:

"144. The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may, when-^{Travel}
ever he deems it necessary for the protection of a region ^{permit.}
declared to be a "fire district", require that everyone wishing
to enter or travel about in such region, between the 1st
of April and the 15th of November, shall previously obtain
a permit."

2. This act shall come into force on the day of its ^{Coming into}
