



## CHAPTER 43

An Act to amend the Quebec Fisheries Act respecting  
certain offences

*[Assented to, the 17th of December, 1931]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the  
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly  
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Quebec Fisheries Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 83,  
chapter 83) is amended by adding thereto, after section 64 <sup>s. 64a,</sup>  
thereof, the following section: <sup>added.</sup>

**"64a.** Every person who hinders, molests or obstructs <sup>Offences</sup>  
a fishery overseer, a special officer or a club guardian in the <sup>and</sup>  
performance of any duty incumbent upon him under this <sup>penalties.</sup>  
act, shall be guilty of an infringement of its provisions and  
shall be liable, in addition to the costs, to a fine of not less  
than ten dollars nor more than fifty dollars, and, in default  
of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not  
less than eight days nor more than one month."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its <sup>Coming into</sup>  
sanction. <sup>force.</sup>
