



## CHAPTER 59

### An Act to amend the Education Act respecting the collection of taxes

*[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 499 of the Education Act (Revised Statutes, R. S., c. 133, 1925, chapter 133) is amended:

*a.* By inserting therein, after the words: "Magistrate's Court", in the third line of the first paragraph thereof, the words: "or the Recorder's Court";

*b.* By striking out the words: "composed of three judges", in the third and fourth lines of the second paragraph thereof;

*c.* By adding thereto, after the third paragraph thereof, the following paragraphs:

"Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the Execution of execution of a judgment rendered by the Recorder's Court judgment. for the recovery of school taxes may be effected by the seizure and sale of the immoveable property of the defendant.

The execution of such a judgment on the immoveable Rules applicable. property as well as the subsequent proceedings shall be made according to the same rules as those enacted in similar matters by the Code of Civil Procedure for the Circuit Court."

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into sanction. force.
