



## CHAPTER 65

### An Act to amend the Officers of Justice Salary Act

*[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** Section 2 of the Officers of Justice Salary Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 155) is amended: R. S., c. 155,  
s. 2, am.

*a.* By replacing the number: "II", in the sixth line of the second paragraph thereof, by the number: "VI";

*b.* By replacing the third paragraph thereof by the following paragraphs:

"The commission of two and one-half per cent that the sheriff is authorized to charge upon and retain out of the sales of immoveables made by himself or by curators or liquidators shall be calculated upon the highest amount, represented either by the amount realized by the sale, or that of the municipal valuation of the immoveable, if any there be. If the immoveable has not been valued for municipal purposes, the Provincial Treasurer shall value the immoveable and the commission shall be calculated upon such valuation." Valuation  
by Prov.  
Treasurer.

**2.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into  
force.
