



CHAPTER 67

An Act to amend the Moving Picture Act

[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Section 4 of the Moving Picture Act (Revised Stat-^{R. S., c. 174,}
utes, 1925, chapter 174), as amended by the act 18 George ^{s. 4, am.}
V, chapter 60, section 2, is again amended by replacing the
first paragraph thereof by the following paragraph:

"4. Every infraction of the provisions of this division ^{Penalty.}
shall be punishable by a fine of not more than fifty dollars,
in addition to the costs, and, in default of payment of such
fine and costs, by imprisonment of not more than one
month, and, in the case of any subsequent offence, by a fine
of not less than fifty dollars nor more than one hundred
dollars, in addition to the costs, and, in default of payment
of such fine and costs, by imprisonment for not more than
two months."

2. Section 19 of the said act, as amended by the acts 18 ^{R. S., c. 174,}
George V, chapter 60, section 4, and 20 George V, chapter ^{s. 19, am.}
75, section 2, is again amended by inserting therein, after
the word: "liable", in the seventh line of the first paragraph
thereof, the words: ", in addition to the costs,".

3. Section 20 of the said act is amended by inserting ^{Id., s. 20,}
therein, after the word: "liable", in the fifth line of the ^{am.}
second paragraph thereof, the words: ", in addition to the
costs,".

R. S., c. 174, Div. III B, added. **4.** The said act is amended by adding thereto, after section 30a thereof, as enacted by the act 20 George V, chapter 76, section 1, the following division and section:

“DIVISION III B

“EXPENSES

Tariff of fees.

“**30b.** The Lieutenant-Governor in Council may establish, amend, replace and repeal the tariff of fees which may be granted to the clerks, bailiffs, peace officers, constables, advocates, inspectors and officers of the commission, in any suit or action brought under this act.”

Coming into force.

5. This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
