



## CHAPTER 72

### An Act respecting Marriage Licenses

*[Assented to, the 22nd of December, 1931]*

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Marriage License Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 203, chapter 203) is amended by inserting therein, after section <sup>s. 6a, added.</sup> 6 thereof, the following section:

**“6a.** Every marriage license issued under this act shall remain in force and be effective for one year only from the date of issue of the said license.” <sup>Duration of marriage license.</sup>

**2.** Article 59a of the Civil Code, as contained in article C. C., art. 5785 of the Revised Statutes of 1888, and replaced by the <sup>59a, am.</sup> act 3 Edward VII, chapter 47, section 1, and amended by the act 9 George V, chapter 24, section 3, is again amended by inserting therein, after the second paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

**“All such licenses shall remain in force and be effective for the period fixed in section 6a of the Marriage License Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 203).”** <sup>Duration of marriage license.</sup>

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. <sup>Coming into force.</sup>
