



## CHAPTER 72

### An Act respecting Marriage Licenses

[Assented to, the 22nd of December, 1931]

**HIS MAJESTY**, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

**1.** The Marriage License Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, R. S., c. 203, chapter 203) is amended by inserting therein, after section <sup>s. 6a, added.</sup> 6 thereof, the following section:

“**6a.** Every marriage license issued under this act shall remain in force and be effective for one year only from the date of issue of the said license.” Duration of marriage license.

**2.** Article 59a of the Civil Code, as contained in article 5785 of the Revised Statutes of 1888, and replaced by the act 3 Edward VII, chapter 47, section 1, and amended by the act 9 George V, chapter 24, section 3, is again amended by inserting therein, after the second paragraph thereof, the following paragraph:

“All such licenses shall remain in force and be effective for the period fixed in section 6a of the Marriage License Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 203).” Duration of marriage license.

**3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction. Coming into force.
