



CHAPTER 79

An Act respecting certain acquisitions and alienations of
immoveable property by corporations and persons in
mortmain

[Assented to, the 17th of December, 1931]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly
of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Any other provision to the contrary notwithstanding, every acquisition and alienation of immoveable property and every hypothec made or granted by a person in mortmain or a corporation, without authorization in cases where authorization is required, shall be valid, provided they are otherwise legal, if a special permit relating thereto, as provided by the Mortmain Act (Revised Statutes, 1925, chapter 229), or if the general permit, mentioned in paragraph 2 of section 5 of the said act, is issued in virtue of the provisions thereof.

2. The validations enacted by the preceding section 1 shall not, however, affect pending cases.
