



CHAPTER 99

An Act to amend Articles 648 and 728 of the Code of Civil Procedure

[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]

HIS MAJESTY, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. Article 648 of the Code of Civil Procedure is replaced by the following: C. C. P., art. 648, replaced.

“648. Oppositions are served upon the sheriff or the bailiff by leaving with him the original thereof and upon the party seizing or his attorney by leaving with him a copy thereof.” Serving of oppositions.

2. Article 728 of the said Code, as amended by the act 17 George V, chapter 72, section 1, is amended by replacing the first paragraph thereof by the following paragraph: C. C. P., art. 728, am.

“728. Every opposition to the seizure and sale must be served on the sheriff by delivering to him the original thereof, and upon the party seizing or his attorney by delivering to him a copy thereof, at the latest on the twelfth day before that fixed for the sale.” Serving of oppositions.

3. This act shall come into force on the 1st of July, 1932. Coming into force.
