



CHAPTER 104

An Act to amend the charter of the city of Quebec

[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]

WHEREAS the city of Quebec has, by its petition, re-^{Preamble.}
presented that it is in the interest of the city and
necessary for the proper administration of its affairs, that
its charter, the act 19 George V, chapter 95, be amended;
and

Whereas it is expedient to grant its prayer;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of
Quebec, enacts as follows:

1. The city is authorized to pay, on a resolution of its^{Subscription}
council, the sum of ten thousand dollars as a subscription^{to Gaspé}
towards the erection of the national cathedral of Gaspé.^{cathedral.}

2. The city is authorized to pay to the Commercial^{Payment to}
Academy of Quebec a yearly sum not to exceed five thou-^{Commercial}
sand dollars, during ten years, for the establishing of a^{Academy.}
commercial high school in Quebec, on the conditions which
shall be fixed by the council.

3. The city may, at any time and from time to time,^{Temporary}
borrow temporarily, to the extent of the total amount of^{loans.}
the taxes imposed to provide for the requirements of the
Roman Catholic Board of School Commissioners and the
Protestant Board of School Commissioners, the sums
which it may need, in anticipation of the collection of the
said real estate taxes imposed for such purpose, provided^{Proviso.}
that such loans be repaid and discharged out of the said
taxes.

The total amount required for each of the above-men-^{Payments}
tioned school boards shall be payable, each year, in the^{to school}
boards.

following manner: one-tenth on the 15th of July; two-tenths on the 15th of October; four-tenths on the 15th of November; one-tenth on the 15th of January, 15th of February and 15th of March, respectively.

19 Geo. V, c. 96, s. 1, am. **4.** Section 1 of the act 19 George V, chapter 96, is amended by replacing the words: "Widening of St. Paul street, north side, between Parent square and Dalhousie street", in the thirteenth and fourteenth lines of paragraph *a* thereof, by the words: "Widening of St. Paul street, between Parent square and Dalhousie street".

19 Geo. V, c. 95, s. 366, am. **5.** Section 336 of the act 19 George V, chapter 95, as amended by the act 21 George V, chapter 122, section 8, is again amended by replacing paragraph 172 thereof by the following:

Maternity hospitals, etc. "172. To regulate private maternity hospitals and infant homes; such regulation shall be subject to the approval of the Director of the Provincial Bureau of Health."

19 Geo. V, c. 96, s. 402, replaced. **6.** Section 402 of the act 19 George V, chapter 95, is replaced by the following:

Appointment and dismissal of members of police force and fire brigade. "**402.** Every member of the police force shall be appointed and dismissed by a committee composed of the mayor, the chief of police and an alderman appointed for this purpose by the council. Every member of the fire brigade shall be appointed and dismissed by a committee composed of the mayor, the chief of the fire brigade and an alderman appointed for this purpose by the council, and sections 401 and 411 are amended accordingly."

19 Geo. V, c. 95, s. 455, am. **7.** Section 455 of the act 19 George V, chapter 95, is amended by replacing the first paragraph thereof by the following:

Maintenance of certain avenues in winter. "**455.** The city is authorized, upon agreement with the National Battlefields Commission, to maintain during the winter, in conformity with the laws and by-laws in force for the other streets in the wards where such avenues are situated, every avenue of the Battlefields Park bordered by properties other than those of the National Battlefields Commission."

19 Geo. V, c. 95, s. 511, replaced. **8.** Section 511 of the act 19 George V, chapter 95, is replaced by the following:

"511. The city shall introduce drains and water from Drains and the waterworks into all the streets of the city in which the water intro- revenue from the water shall equal at least six per cent of streets. the cost of the introduction of the drains and water."

9. The city of Quebec is authorized, by resolution of Certain its council, to grant a commutation of taxes to the "Army commuta- and Navy Veterans Quebec Unit No. 33 Building Asso- tion of taxes ciation Inc.", by fixing the valuation of the immoveables authorized. of the said association at the sum of two hundred thousand dollars, on which valuation shall be based the taxes of the said association, municipal as well as school, and this for a period of ten years from the 1st of May, 1932.

10. This act shall come into force on the day of its Coming into sanction. force.
