



CHAPTER 121

An Act to detach certain lots from the parish of St. Armand West and to annex them to the municipality of the village of Philipsburg, in the county of Missisquoi, for municipal purposes

[Assented to, the 19th of February, 1932]

WHEREAS the municipality of the village of Philipsburg, Preamble.
the municipality of the parish of St. Armand West, and Wallace Sandstone Quarries, Limited, a body politic and corporate, applied, on the 28th of February, 1920, by petition to the Lieutenant-Governor in Council, for the annexation, to the municipality of the village of Philipsburg, of lots Nos. 40 and 41 of the official cadastre of the parish of St. Armand West, which form part of lots Nos. 5 and 6 of the original division of the Seigniorie of St. Armand, and for the annexation, to the same municipality, of a certain road leading from the village of Philipsburg to the station of the Vermont Central Railway in the parish of St. Armand West;

Whereas in conformity with section 413 of the Municipal Code, as amended by the act 11 George V, chapter 48, section 27, an Order-in-Council, No. 1513, was adopted on the 4th of August, 1921, approving a by-law ordering the annexation of the said public road, but the annexation of the above-mentioned lots Nos. 40 and 41 was not ordered;

Whereas after the date of the Order-in-Council annexing the road, the persons interested, erroneously but in good faith, believed that the said lots 40 and 41 had been detached from the parish of St. Armand West and annexed to the village of Philipsburg, and have since acted as if they had been annexed;

Whereas it is expedient to pass an act to remedy the error committed and to order the annexation which exists *de facto* as above stated;

Therefore, His Majesty, with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of Quebec, enacts as follows:

Certain lots detached from St. Armand West and annexed to Philipsburg. **1.** The lots numbers 40 and 41 of the official cadastre of the parish of St. Armand West, in the county of Missisquoi, are detached from the said parish and are annexed to the municipality of the village of Philipsburg, in the same county, for municipal purposes.

Retroactive effect. **2.** This act shall be deemed to have been in force since the 4th of August, 1921.

Coming into force. **3.** This act shall come into force on the day of its sanction.
